Exploration and Creation

At various points in the stories, our facilitators will pause and guide each class in exploring and creating the world of the story. Your child will be engaged in role-playing, performing short scenes, creating freeze frames and even adding their own ideas into the story.

Rehearsing and Performing

As each class begins to assemble their own little creations, our facilitators will guide our participants, encouraging them in developing their confidence and performance skills - especially when it comes to public speaking, facial expressions, body language, movement and more.

FOR AGES 9 TO 12: ACTS OF IMAGINATION

MODULE: **DEVISING PERFORMANCE**

In the theatre, we very often begin with a script that tells us everything about the play. In 'Devising Performance', we take a different approach to telling stories and performing scenes. Throughout this term, our participants become co-creators - actors who are empowered to think and create as they learn. With the help of our trained facilitators, they will become key decision-makers in the stories that they tell. Who are the characters in the scene? What conflict exists between these characters? What happens at the end? What does this story mean?

For 9-10 Year Olds: Contentless Scenes

Students will be provided with scenes but no additional context. They will have to think and talk about what the story is, even as they figure out their roles in it.

For 11-12 Year Olds: From Scratch

Students will be given a theme to discuss, after which they will decide the setting, characters and plot of the play they will eventually perform.

Developing Good Stories

Through brainstorming, improvising and testing scenes, students will learn the key elements of good stories - from establishing context and conflict development to creating satisfying and meaningful resolutions.

From Page to Stage

After they have decided on the stories they will tell, students will learn to communicate with audiences - 'showing' rather 'telling' what they want to say and the messages they hope to convey.

Physical, Vocal and Facial Expressions

In every lesson, your child will be engaged in creating scenes that will become part of their final performance. They will be guided in playing their characters - learning how to convey personalities and emotions through their body language, voices and facial expressions.

Terms & Conditions

Payment: Payments must be made in full before the start of the first lesson. If any payment which are due are not made by their respective due dates, Wild Rice Ltd will have the right to exclude any participant from the class.

Costumes: Please note an additional costume fee of up to \$50 per child will be collected after the programme has started. (The confirmed amount will be informed to parents/guardians at a later date).

Confirmation of Class: Please note, the class can only be confirmed once it reaches a minimum number of 9 participants per class. Wild Rice Ltd reserves the right to cancel a class if the minimum number of participants per class is not met.

Missed Lessons: There will be no replacement or refund for any missed lessons.

Withdrawal Policy:

At least 14 days prior to commencement of programme: 100% refund of the remaining fee after deduction of \$50 administration fee.

Less than 14 days prior to commencement of programme: 50% of the programme fee will be refunded after deduction of \$50 administration fee if it is due to medical reasons and supported by a doctor's letter. No refund will be made on any other grounds.

Once the programme has started: 50% of the remaining unattended lesson fees (pro-rated based on the remaining number of sessions), after a deduction of \$50 administration fee will be refunded if it is due to medical reasons and supported by a doctor's letter. No refund will be made on any other grounds. Refunds will be done via Cheque and will be posted out to the address provided.

Illness: In the event that your child is not feeling well, please do not bring them for lessons. We seek your consideration, and request that any child that is unwell to rest at home. This is to avoid spreading any illness to other children who are attending the workshops. Wild Rice Ltd reserves the right to ask parents/guardians to take their child(ren) home if they arrive at the class and are feeling unwell.

Pick Up & Dismissal Policy: It is encouraged to exercise punctuality and arrive before dismissal time to pick up the child. Any child, below the age of 7 years old will not be released unaccompanied, and unsupervised, without first completing a signed release form that is submitted and acknowledged by Wild Rice Ltd.

In the event you are not present to collect your child when the class finishes, they remain with their teacher as the next class commences. Please ensure that you are prompt in picking up your child/ward to avoid any interruption of the class. If you know in advance you will be late, please contact us via the Academy phone number.

Showcase: On the final session, there will be a showcase, and each participant will be entitled to invite two guests to attend. Additional invitations are subject to a cost, and availability.

Photography & Videography: We may take photos and video record the sessions from time to time. This may be used for publicity, media and archival purposes. By agreeing to these Terms and Conditions, parents and/or guardians grants Wild Rice Ltd their permission to use the recordings in any materials, either printed or electronically.
