**WILD RICE ANNOUNCES FINAL THREE SHOWS  
TO CLOSE 2023 ON A HIGH NOTE**



29 June 2023 – Wild Rice today announced the final three shows of its 2023 season: ***Psychobitch***, ***G\*d Is A Woman*** and ***Snow White & the Seven Dwarfs***.

**A Thrilling New Gender Power Play**

Written with dark humour and searing insight by Amanda Chong, **PSYCHOBITCH** introduces us to overachieving journalist Anya Samuel just as her fiancé tasks her to explain the four times she has cried in public since they started dating. (See **Annex A** for more information.)

Directed by Pam Oei and starring Sindhura Kalidas, this thought-provoking one-woman show boldly dissects gender power dynamics and the subtle shades of toxic relationships.

“*Psychobitch* speaks of the stereotype associated with female emotionalism, but Anya Samuel’s journey is one that all of us have been on,” says Chong. “Ultimately, this play is about our deeply human desire to be fully known and fully loved, and the toxic circumstances we often tolerate to fulfil that, until we come to know our worth. As Anya examines her life with wit and vulnerability, I hope she gives us permission to laugh at ourselves and, above all, to hope.”

## **A Side-Splitting Satire about Singapore's Cancel Culture**

Howlingly funny and gleefully irreverent in equal measure, Joel Tan's **G\*D IS A WOMAN** explores what happens when a fake petition to cancel Ariana Grande gets taken so seriously that her upcoming concert in Singapore comes under threat. (See **Annex B** for more information.)

A devastatingly sharp satire on censorship, complaint culture and moral outrage on the Singaporean internet, this brand-new play will be directed by Ivan Heng, Wild Rice's Founding Artistic Director.

"In writing this play, I'm taking revenge on the killjoys who run our country. But rest assured it's very equal-opportunity – *everyone* gets slagged for taking themselves too seriously," says Tan. "I hope audiences walk away from the show a little damp, because I just want them to laugh so hard that they end up peeing themselves a little!"

## **The *Perfect* Musical Comedy For The Whole Family**

Last, but certainly not least, Wild Rice continues its annual holiday tradition of entertaining the entire family with Alfian Sa'at's **SNOW WHITE & THE SEVEN DWARFS**, a hilarious, heartwarming musical comedy that puts a joyously Singaporean spin on one of the world's most beloved fairy tales. This reimagined production will be directed by Hossan Leong, with a brand-new cast led by Chua Enlai as the Queen, Nadya Zaheer as Snow White, and Siti Khalijah Zainal as the Magic Mirror.

First staged in 2008, this riotously funny musical marked the first time Alfian tried his hand at writing a Wild Rice pantomime – which meant that he had to create a show that would play as satisfactorily for children *and* adults.

"I'm excited to see how children will respond to the familiar story of Snow White – now that it comes with new layers, where it deals with themes such as the pursuit of perfection and how this affects one's self-image and self-esteem," says Alfian.

"While Snow White is the protagonist, I think many will identify with the dwarves – as misfits who have been banished – because they do not conform to certain norms. I hope that the audience will leave the show feeling hopeful that difference is not something to be afraid of, but something that we can acknowledge and celebrate."

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## SYNOPSIS

### PLAYWRIGHTS

#### **ALFIAN SA'AT – Playwright of *Snow White & The Seven Dwarfs***

Alfian is the Resident Playwright of Wild Rice. He has been nominated at the Straits Times Life! Theatre Awards for Best Original Script 12 times, and has received the award four times. His plays with Wild Rice include *HOTEL* (with Marcia Vanderstraaten), *The Asian Boys Trilogy*, *Cooling-Off Day*, *The Optic Trilogy* and *Homesick*. He was the winner of the Golden Point Award for Poetry and the National Arts Council Young Artist Award for Literature in 2001. His publications include *Collected Plays One, Two and Three*; poetry collections *One Fierce Hour*, *A History of Amnesia* and *The Invisible Manuscript*; and short story collections *Corridor* and *Malay Sketches*.

#### **AMANDA CHONG – Playwright of *Psychobitch***

Amanda is a lawyer trained in Cambridge and Harvard who writes when she should be sleeping. Amanda explores themes of gender and power in her work as a poet and playwright. Her poetry collection, *Professions*, was shortlisted for the Singapore Literature Prize, and her poetry is studied in the Cambridge International GCSE Syllabus. Her staged plays include the musical *The Feelings Farm* (The Esplanade, 2021) and *#WomenSupportingWomen* (winner of T:>Works' 24-Hour Playwriting Competition in 2021).

#### **JOEL TAN – Playwright of *G\*d Is A Woman***

Joel's recent work in Singapore includes *Tartuffe: The Imposter* and *The Butterfly Lovers* (Wild Rice); *Tango* (Pangdemonium); *Mosaic* (M1 Fringe Festival) and *Café* (Twenty Something Theatre Festival). He first worked with Wild Rice in 2011 on the Singapore Theatre Festival premiere of his play, *Family Outing*. In the UK, recent productions include *No Particular Order* (Theatre 503), *When the Daffodils* (Orange Tree Theatre) and *Living Newspaper* (The Royal Court). He is on commission with Royal Court Theatre, Headlong Theatre and Almeida Theatre.

### DIRECTORS

#### **IVAN HENG – Director of *G\*d Is A Woman***

In a pioneering career spanning more than three decades, Ivan has directed, acted in and designed many landmark Singapore theatre productions that have been performed in more than 20 cities around the world. Ivan founded Wild Rice in 2000. Together with Executive Director Tony Trickett, he envisioned a new home for the company – a groundbreaking iconic theatre that opened in the heart of Singapore's civic and cultural district in 2019. Under Ivan's leadership, Wild Rice has reached out to an audience of over a million people, and is today at the vanguard of creating theatre with a distinctive Singaporean voice. In 2013, Ivan was awarded the Cultural Medallion, Singapore's highest cultural honour.

### **HOSSAN LEONG – Director of *Snow White & the Seven Dwarfs***

Hossan, Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres, is one of Singapore's most loved and recognised entertainers. Affectionately known as 'Singapore Boy', he is a consummate performer whose skills include directing, singing, dancing, acting, piano-playing and stand-up comedy. He is actively involved in theatre, television, film and radio.

### **PAM OEI – Director of *Psychobitch***

Pam has been in over 100 theatre, television and film productions. Theatre acting credits include the critically acclaimed *Faghag*, *HOTEL*, *Animal Farm*, *Everything But The Brain*, *Rent* and *Boeing Boeing*. She is probably best known for being one third of Singapore's favourite cabaret trio, The Dim Sum Dollies. Her directing credits for Wild Rice include *Pinocchio*, *Mama White Snake*, *Boeing Boeing*, *The Emperor's New Clothes* and *Hansel & Gretel*.
